Junior centerfielder Heidi Brooks (Wayland, NY/Wayland-Cohocton) went 2-3 with a pair of RBIs and a run scored. Sophomore catcher Gretchen Weidner (Eden, NY/Eden) was 2-3 with a two-run double and senior second baseman Andrea Crandall (Alfred, NY/Alfred-Almond) had an RBI and a run scored.
