

AU men's outdoor track and field team places 26th at ECAC championships

SPRINGFIELD, MA -- The Alfred University men's outdoor track and field team competed in the Eastern College Athletic Conference (ECAC) Division III championship meet Thursday and Friday at Springfield College. Of 47 teams scoring points at the meet, the Saxons scored 12 points to finish in a tie for 26th. In his final collegiate competition, senior Steve Robin (Foster, RI, Ponaganset) took second in the pole vault (4.52 meters). During his AU career, Robin won one ECAC outdoor pole vault title (2003) and twice won state indoor titles (2004 and 2005). He set the AU indoor pole vault record (4.67 meters) at a meet this winter at St. Lawrence. Senior Ryan Bank (St. Johnsbury, VT/St. Johnsbury) wrapped up his career at AU with a fifth-place finish in the 3,000-meter steeplechase (9:30.78). Bank set an AU record (9:26.70) in that event at a meet earlier this spring at Roberts Wesleyan. Senior Nate Corney (Walworth Gananda) placed 14th in the 110-meter hurdles (15.59 seconds), while sophomore Dan Ohart (Williamsport, PA/Williamsport) was ninth in the javelin throw (53.37 meters).
