

## **'Conjunction' on display at Museum of Ceramic Art**

"Conjunction," an exhibition featuring work from three of the collections at the Schein-Joseph International Museum of Ceramic Art at Alfred University, will be on display at the museum through Sept. 30. "Conjunction" features work from the Corsaw, Fox and Krevolin collections. The Corsaw Collection, created by a gift from the late Roger Corsaw, an AU alumnus, includes functional American ceramics; the Fox Collection includes Korean ceramics; and the Krevolin Collection, a gift from Lewis and Jenny Gobert Krevolin, who are both AU graduates. The Krevolin Collection includes pottery from the Ancient Americas. The Museum is located on the second floor of Binns-Merrill Hall on the AU campus.
