

"Conjunction" Reception Slated

ALFRED, NY - There will be a reception for "Conjunction," an exhibit featuring work from three of the collections at the Schein-Joseph International Museum of Ceramic Art at Alfred University, from 4:30-6 p.m., Thursday, Sept. 8. "Conjunction," which runs through Friday, Sept. 30, can be viewed on the top floor of Binns-Merrill Hall, Wednesday-Friday, from 10 a.m.-4 p.m. The exhibit features work from the Corsaw, Fox, and Krevolin collections. The Corsaw Collection, created by a gift from the late Roger Corsaw, an Alfred University alumnus, includes functional American ceramics; the Fox Collection includes Korean ceramics; and the Krevolin Collection, a gift from Lewis and Jenny Gobert Krevolin, who are both AU graduates, includes pottery from the Ancient Americas.
