

Kwong to exhibit work at Museum of Ceramic Art at Alfred

- Ceramic artist Eva Kwong will have a solo exhibition of her work at the Schein-Joseph International Museum of Ceramic Art at Alfred. "Love Between the Atoms" opens Oct. 12 and will remain on display through Dec. 16. A reception will be held at 4:30 p.m. Oct. 20 at the Museum, which is located in Binns-Merrill Hall on the Alfred University campus. A graduate of the Rhode Island School of Design, Kwong is known for her "colorful, sensuous, provocative and organic forms." Her ceramic pieces may be found in private and public collections, including those at the Archie Bray Foundation, Mint Museum of Craft + Design, the Minneapolis Institute of Art, the Finnish Craft Museum and the Racine Museum of Art. Her work has been exhibited nationally and internationally, and she has lectured extensively. She earned a Master of Fine Arts degree from Tyler School of Art in Philadelphia, and is the recipient of numerous Ohio Art Council Fellowships, as well as a National Endowment for the Arts Fellowship and other honors.
