

Zweygardt's work selected for purchase prize

"Human Relations," a stone, glass and bronze piece sculpture by Glenn Zweygardt, professor of sculpture at the School of Art & Design at Alfred University, will become part of the permanent collection of the University of West Alabama. His piece, included in the Fourth Biennial University of West Alabama Outdoor Sculpture Exhibition, sponsored by the Sumter County Fine Arts Council, was selected for the "purchase award," meaning it will be permanently installed on the Livingston, AL, campus. The exhibition included eight pieces by seven artists and represented, according to director Jason Guynes, "some of the best in contemporary sculpture and reflect the diversity of the art form in America today." Zweygardt, who has been a member of the Alfred University faculty since 1969, is nationally acclaimed for his large-scale, mixed media sculptures. He received his Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from Wichita State University in 1967, and an MFA from the Maryland Institute of Art in 1969.
