

Summer School Program registration under way

Registration for Alfred University Summer School, which begins Monday, May 14, is underway and continues until three days before the first class. Summer School at AU offers an opportunity to take a full semester course in just two, three, four or six weeks. It is a chance to make up a course, get ahead or even enjoy the scenic beauty of Alfred during the summer. AU's Summer School offers a variety of graduate and undergraduate courses. Two, six-week sessions, special short-term courses of one, two, three or four weeks, internships and independent studies allow you to easily plan a schedule that fits your needs and interests. There must be at least two students registered for most summer courses in order for the class to be held. For part-time students (taking 11 credit hours or less), tuition for non-art undergraduate courses is \$690/credit hour. The tuition for non-art graduate courses is \$630/credit hour. Tuition for summer art courses (both graduate and undergraduate) is \$430/credit hour (plus applicable fees). In addition to the tuition cost, all part-time students must pay a \$70 student service fee. Some classes also require a lab or material fees. Housing is available on campus May 13-Aug. 4. While no meal plan is available over the summer, the Cyber Fresh Caf is open for lunch on weekdays during Summer session I and II, and the Powell Dining Hall is open on a limited, cash-only basis during Summer Session II. Students will be housed in suites or apartments so they can prepare their own food when necessary. Also, some summer job positions will be available. The Human Resources Office staff can assist in making contact with other offices on campus that have summer jobs available.
