

## **Students ready for first Relay for Life event**

The American Cancer Society is sponsoring Alfred University's first-ever "Relay for Life" event, on Friday, April 13, a relay walk fundraiser for cancer research. AU student Kali Littlefield, AU's Relay for Life entertainment chair, takes funding for cancer research personally. "My grandmother, when I was really young, died of cancer," she said. "I want to help with the problem." Although cancer is no laughing matter, Littlefield says that she is working hard to make AU's first relay for life entertaining. "(Even though) this is a serious event, it should also be a fun event at the same time," she said. The Relay for Life event will run from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m in AU's Davis Gym. As teams of two to 15 people walk the track, audience members will be entertained as they cheer them on. All AU community members, including faculty, students and the general public, are encouraged to participate in this event, whether on the track or in the audience. The price of admission for this cancer prevention fundraiser is \$10. Relay for Life organizers hope this event will be the first of many. They will range from Midnight Renewal, a new wave SKA group, to Shock Wave Production's DJ Dave, from Rochester, to AU's acapella groups Acafellas and Lady 8.
