

Alfred University names new professor of dance

D. Chase Angier has been appointed an assistant professor of dance in Alfred University's Division of Performing Arts. She comes to Alfred from the American Academy of the Dramatic Arts in New York City. Angier, who earned a B.A. degree in dance from UCLA and a Master of Fine Arts degree in dance with an emphasis in choreography from Ohio State University, has previously taught at Columbia College, Columbia, SC; Appalachian State University, Boone, NC, and Ohio State, Columbus, OH. Since 1995, she has also been a teaching artist at the Lincoln Center Institute, instructing students in kindergarten through 12th grade, as well as conducting professional development workshops for New York City teachers. She has been choreographer for a number of dance theater productions and theatrical productions, and has performed with dance companies including Chase Dance Theater, Margalit Oved Dance Theater, Moving Arts Dance Theater Company, and the UCLA Dance Company. Angier has performed in a number of dance concerts and has been a principal dancer in several television productions, including two MTV commercials, a Nickelodeon commercial and a Taylor Dane music video.
