

Alfred University to announce results of national survey

The results of the nation's first comprehensive survey of high school students and school violence will be released at a press conference 10 a.m. Tuesday, August 28, at the National Press Club (Lisagor Room). The survey, entitled "Lethal Violence in Schools," was conducted by researchers at Alfred University in New York. It surveyed seventh to 12th graders nationwide about what they believe leads to such acts of violence as school shootings, the safety and potential for violence at their schools, their own propensity to violent acts, and the roles of teachers and parents in school violence.
