It is my distinct pleasure to invite you to attend the SUNY Lifesaver Program. This program is designed to comply with enactment of the state's AED Legislation and to train University faculty, staff, and students in the skills of CPR and use of an AED.

This CPR/AED certification program has been approved by the NYS Department of Health. It is the equivalent to the American Red Cross and American Heart Association CPR/ AED programs. Upon completion you will receive a certificate that authorizes you to perform CPR on adults, infants and children.

EH&S is actively seeking volunteers for this program. At this time, anyone who wishes to participate and become certified is welcome to attend the training sessions. In particular, we need to have at least 3 volunteers from each floor in Binns Merrill Hall, Harder Hall and McMahon Engineering Building.

Alert: PayPal e-mail hoax and Web page scams

There are many e-mail hoaxes out there that ask for your personal information and credit card

numbers. Please remember, if it is a legitimate e-mail they will NEVER ask you for your personal information OR your credit card number.

If you get something from a bank, Ebay, or PayPal, etc. and you have never used the service, it is a hoax. Delete it without opening any of the links. If you do get something from your bank and you question the legitimacy, call them to see if they sent it to you.

Remember, always err on the side of caution. Do not give your personal information out in an e-mail. You should only provide personal and financial information when you are purchasing something from a site that you trust and where you have initiated the transaction.
