### Important health alert

Alfred University has experienced two possible cases of pertussis (whooping cough). AU students at known risk have been contacted and received preventative medical treatment. Test results for the affected students are not available yet, so please be aware that these cases are not confirmed at this time.

Pertussis may begin with cold symptoms and a cough that becomes much worse over 1-2 weeks. Symptoms usually include a long series of coughs ("coughing fits") followed by a whooping noise. However, older children, adults and very young infants may not develop the whoop. There is generally no fever. People with pertussis may have a series of coughs followed by vomiting, turning blue, or

difficulty catching their breath. The cough is often worse at night and cough medicines usually do not help alleviate the cough.

**IMPORTANT:** If you have symptoms of a cold with fever and persistent cough, call the Crandall Health Center (2400) and speak with a nurse about your symptoms. Remember, we work together to prevent the spread of communicable disease. When you're coughing and sneezing do it in your sleeves (not your hands!). Wash your hands often and with soap or use a hand sanitizer. Keep 3-8 feet between yourself and someone who is ill. Be sure your immunization vaccines are up to date and take good care of your health through proper rest, exercise, and good eating. We are researching local availability of the vaccine.

Although pertussis is communicable and easily spreads from an infected individual to others, healthy young adults rarely experience serious illness. The reason outbreaks must be vigorously controlled is due to the fact that this infection may become a severe illness in infants and young children.
