Who Needs BBP Training? Anyone with potential to come in contact with bodily fluids (Physical Plant, Custodians, Maintenance, Technicians, appropriate Faculty, and AU Rescue Squad)

Training Description: Liquid or semi-liquid blood or OPIM, contaminated items that would release blood or other bodily fluids contaminated with blood when compressed, contaminated sharps, pathological and microbiological waste containing blood or other bodily fluids contaminated with blood.

Training is provided to all employees who handle this type of contamination. It is to be disposed of at the Health Center under regulations guided by the NYSDEC as regulated medical waste.
