Block Meals - All you care to eat meals in Powell and Ade Dining Halls. Meals are good for breakfast, lunch, or dinner, during regular serving hours and are valid until May 12, 2008.

Block of 10 Meals - \$50  
Block of 18 Meals - \$75  
Block of 25 Meals - \$100

Dining Dollars (DD) - Open an account of \$50 or more and receive five additional Dining Dollars for every \$50 purchased.

Purchase \$50 and receive \$55 in DD
