Emergency notification at AU

In the event of an emergency, please be aware of the following ways that AU staff will try to communicate with you:

1. Text Messaging Alerts - STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. To sign up for this service, go to <http://my.alfred.edu/text...>, and login using your e-mail username and password. Fill in the additional information and have your cell phone ready to receive a verification txt message. The whole process takes less than 2 minutes. This is a free service from AU, though normal text messages fees through your provider apply. Please note, however, that you should not receive more than a few of these each semester, so it's well worth the few cents it may cost. (While you're registering for the text message service, you can also opt to receive texts from other areas of interest. Even if you do not choose any interest group, you will receive emergency alerts).

2. Campus-wide e-mail - in the event of an emergency an e-mail will be sent to your Alfred e-mail account

3. Broadcast voice mail - An automated voice mail will go to all faculty, staff and student voice mailboxes (if you have signed-up for a voice mailbox through the telephone office).

Additional notifications would be made as time and the situation permits, but please be aware that at minimum, we would be using the three methods above. We strongly urge you to sign up for text message alerts.
