Sept. 10 was World Suicide Prevention Day. It's easier than you think to help a student who may be considering self-harm. Asking about behavior and feelings, sharing your concern, and knowing a good referral, can be great first steps toward resolving problems.

It's a good idea to ask more about it when someone:

- \* Talks or jokes about suicide
- \* Drinks too much or uses other drugs
- \* Gets unusually angry or violent
- \* Takes dangerous risks or looks for hair-raising thrills
- \* Stays away from friends and wants to be left alone
- \* Loses interest in how he or she looks
- \* Gives away belongings and favorite objects

People who are feeling depressed or have been through something extremely stressful may think about escaping their problems. If you're concerned about a student, and not sure what to do, call the Counseling and Student Development Center at 871-2300 or send a confidential email to [csdc@alfred.edu](mailto:csdc@alfred.edu) . Alfred University students often have a choice of registering and voting right here in Allegany County (if you have been a resident in your present address for at least 30 days before the election) or voting by absentee ballot in your home county or state. The choice is yours, but please plan to register and vote on Nov. 6.

Voter registrations must be postmarked by Friday, Oct. 12 if you want to vote on Nov. 6 in New York State.
