Try Xreferplus!

Are you looking for a quick way to look up information on a variety of topics? Would you like a resource that includes not only text, but also images, diagrams, maps, photos, and audio recordings?

Xreferplus was recently added to the libraries' online reference collection. We invite you to try it out!

Some features include:

- The ability to view results in the form of a visual concept map, which shows the relationship between your topic and other topics in Xreferplus.
- The ability to prioritize search results by format so that, for example, results with images or audio files come up first.
- Cross-reference links to related entries, suggesting additional resources for your topic.
- Access to statistical data that you can customize and export.

Xreferplus includes content from hundreds of reference books, including encyclopedias, dictionaries, thesauri, books of quotations, and subject-specific titles. A wide range of subjects are covered, including art, biography, business, food, geography, history, languages, law, literature, medicine, philosophy, psychology, religion, science, social science, and technology.
