ITS has been seeing a number of "phishing" e-mails that are asking for personal information. Please note: Banks, credit cards, e-mail providers, etc. will not ask for any personal information over e-mail, including but not limited to your credit card number and/or password information. If an e-mail requests this type of information it is a scam known as "phishing."

You should delete this type of -email immediately. If you have a concern about a certain e-mail you can forward it to ITS at helpdesk@alfred.edu and we can help you decide if it is an official e-mail or not.
