Financial Help for LGBTQ Students

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer (LGBTQ) students seeking financial help for their incoming undergraduate or graduate school education can take action by applying for a Point Foundation Scholarship. Point is the nation's largest scholarship-granting organization for LGBTQ students of merit.

To serve this population, Point Foundation has invested more than \$15 million in education and support of 243 scholars since 2001. Students who will be enrolled in undergraduate or graduate programs for the 2014-5 academic year are eligible to apply. Applicants may submit Part I of the application until 11:59 p.m. PST on Jan. 21, 2014. Point will then invite qualified applicants to submit Part II of the application, which will remain so until 11:59 p.m. PST, Feb. 3, 2014.
