Paolo Cirio of New York City will be participating in the artist-in-residence program of the Institute for Electronic Arts over the week of June 15.

A graduate of the University of Turin, Cirio works as a media artist in various fields, such as new-art, street-art, video, software-art, and experimental fiction, considering how society is organized and impacted by the distribution, organization, and control of information.

Cirio has proposed a project to further develop a technique for painting using laser-cut stencils and custom-made software coding. High Definition Stencils will allow for full-color, CMYK stencils for use in street-art. With each color cut out as a separate stencil with proper dithering, cyan, magenta, yellow, and black paints can be applied to a surface to render a full-color image composite, much like how digital printers produce full color images.

For many years the Finger Lakes region has inspired many local artists with its bountiful natural beauty and world-class wines. Since the first annual Plein Air Arts Festival in 2012, the eastern shore of Seneca Lake has provided a warm atmosphere and stunning backdrop for many artists' works. Now in its 4th year, the festival will once again invite local artists to create artwork en plein air (in open air) throughout the day, followed by an art reception and auction later in the evening, accompanied by live music with local food and wine.

The Plein Air Art Festival is a public event scheduled for Saturday, July 25, 2015, along the eastern side of Seneca Lake. Between 7 a.m. and 3 p.m., artists will be scheduled to create works of art at various partner wineries. A silent auction and reception for the day's plein air artwork will take place from 5 until 7 p.m. at Damiani Wine Cellars.
