Topic: "The Physics of Snowboarding"

Physics is the study of objects in motion, so wouldn't learning physics be more fun if the object in motion is your own body? iPhones have sensors that measure acceleration and rotation, so we can measure the acceleration down a slope or carving turns at high speed.

Flying off jumps is a form of projectile motion. Is snowboarding (or skiing) with an iPhone a good way to learn physics? Does looking at the physics of the sport improve your abilities?

Come find out the results of this experiment in teaching physics the most dynamic way possible from Professor of Physics David DeGraff.
