#### Pollard announces new health center director

I am pleased to announce that Dr. Cathie Chester, who has been director of our Counseling and Wellness Center (CWC), will take on an expanded role as director of the Student Health Center in addition to her current duties.

We are combining our physical and mental health centers because we believe it is best for our students to offer a more holistic approach to health and well-being. This move will allow us to fully integrate the concept of wellness to better meet students' needs.

The change becomes effective in mid-July when Alfred University's contract with St. James Mercy Health expires. The University is in the process of hiring its own staff to operate Crandall Health Center, which is located in the same building on Park Street as the Counseling and Wellness Center.

Cathie Chester had been director of the CWC since 2007, and had been interim director for a year prior to that. She has been superb in her role as CWC director, and I am confident she will perform as well in her expanded role. She is an extremely capable clinician, administrator and professional.

A graduate of Davidson College in Davidson, NC, Cathie completed an M.S. degree in community mental health at Long Island University and joined the staff of the CWC as a counselor in 1987, providing mental health counseling, crisis counseling and outreach services to students.
