

AU men's tennis team splits weekend matches

ERIE, PA -- The Alfred University men's tennis team split two matches played over the weekend in Erie, PA. AU knocked off Penn State-Behrend, 5-2, Friday afternoon, and fell to Frostburg (MD) State, 5-2, Saturday morning. Securing singles wins for AU in the match against Behrend were junior Randy Vecchione (Seaford/Seaford), 6-1, 6-4 in second singles; junior Kevin Dillon (Wellsville/Scio), 6-1, 0-6, 6-1 in fourth singles; sophomore Andrew Lee (Scarsdale/Edgemont), 6-3, 6-1 in fifth singles, and senior Dave Streib (Baldwinsville/C.W. Baker), 3-6, 6-2, 6-4 in sixth singles. Vecchione and Dillon teamed for an 8-6 win in second doubles while sophomore Steve Ventura (Hilton/Hilton) and Lee took their third doubles match, 8-4. In the match against Frostburg, Alfred got singles wins from Lee, 6-0, 6-1 in fifth singles and Streib, 6-4, 7-6 (11-9) in sixth singles. Ventura and Lee teamed to win their third doubles match, 8-1. The Saxons (2-1, 1-0 Empire 8) play next on Monday, April 5, at 3 p.m. at St. John Fisher.
