

## **AU men's swimming team defeats LeMoyne as the women's team falls**

The Alfred University men's swimming team defeated LeMoyne College 171-125 as the women's team fell 171-126 on Saturday afternoon. Leading the men's team was sophomore Page Beecher (Scarborough, ME/ Scarborough) who swept three events: 1000 yard freestyle, 500 yard freestyle and the 200 yard IM. Sophomore Dan Schubmehl (Rochester, NY/ Pennfield) swept both the one meter and three meter diving events. Freshman Brian Agro (Gray, ME/ Cheverus) placed first in the 200 yard breaststroke, second in the 200 yard butterfly and third in the 200 yard IM. Senior Brian Gotham (Syracuse, NY/ Nottingham) had a first place victory in the 100 yard breaststroke and a second place finish in the 200 yard breaststroke. Freshman Matt Baker (Weedsport, NY/ Weedsport), senior Alex Crowell (Wayland, MA/ Wayland), junior Brandon Striker (Caledonia, NY/ York) and Gotham teamed up in the 400 yard freestyle relay in which AU took first place. Gotham, Baker, Beecher and freshman Scott Sarkissian (Oswego, NY/ Oswego) teamed up to win the 400 yard freestyle relay. The women's team was led by sophomore Lindsay Scypta (Plymouth, MI/ Cranbrook Kings) who placed first in the 200 yard breaststroke, second in the 100 yard breaststroke and third in the 200 yard IM. Senior Bonnie McDermott (Grand Island, NY/ Mount St. Mary) took a first place victory in the 100 yard breaststroke and finished second in the 200 yard breaststroke. Junior Jamie Wingate (Groton, NY/ Lansing) took first in the one meter diving event and second in the three meter diving event. Senior Tara Mungro (Rochester, NY/ Wilson Magnet) finished first in the 50 yard freestyle as senior Rachel Saroka (Groton, NY/ Groton) took first in the 100 yard backstroke. Saroka, McDermott, junior Jessica White (Palmyra, NY/ Palmyra-Macedon) and freshman Kalyn Follmer (Windfield, PA/ Lewisburg Area) teamed up together to win the 400 yard Medley Relay. The men's and women's swim teams will meet next Saturday, Jan. 28, home vs. St. Lawrence at 1 p.m.
