

AU men's soccer team beats Hobart

GENEVA The Alfred University men's soccer team defeated Hobart College Saturday afternoon by a 3-1 score. The Saxons (10-1-2, 4-0-1 Empire Eight) fell behind early, but followed up with three unanswered goals to win the game. Scoring for the Saxons began with a goal from freshman midfielder Stephen Robin (Foster, RI/Ponaganset), assisted by senior midfielder Jon Bridges (Topeka, KS/Topeka). In the second half, goals were scored by freshman forward Brendan Rice (Schenectady/Niskayuna) and sophomore midfielder Ian Edmonds (Telford, England/Adams). Assisting on the goal by Edmonds was sophomore defender Chris Dionne (Marbledale, CT/Shepaug Valley). Hobart was led by Jesse Martin, who scored an unassisted first half goal. In goal for the Saxons, junior Kevin Ball (Wheeling, WV/Linsly School) went the distance, allowing a lone goal and making five saves. Goalkeeper Cory Rosier made five saves for Hobart. The Saxons managed 16 shots, while Hobart had 21. The Saxons are next in action Tuesday, when they travel to Pitt-Bradford for a 3:30 match.--30--
