Stay Safe. Respond to Outdoor Warning Siren

Alfred State College will be testing its outdoor warning sirens today, Friday, Aug. 30, 2013 at 10:10 a.m.

In the event of life threatening emergencies, Alfred State will activate the outdoor warning siren. Any emergency that causes ASC to sound their alarm also has the potential to affect people on our campus. If and when you hear the siren, you should immediately return to a known safe, indoor location. Information about the emergency, including instructions about what to do, will be
