

Fisher defeats AU women's lacrosse team

ALFRED, NY - The Alfred University women's lacrosse team lost to visiting St. John Fisher, 16-6, Thursday afternoon at Merrill Field. Alfred (0-3, 0-2 Empire 8) fell behind early, giving up the game's first eight goals before going into halftime down 11-3. Fisher had a 16-4 lead before the Lady Saxons tallied the final two goals of the contest. Sophomore attack Erin Brummer (Williamsville, NY/Williamsville South) scored three goals to pace Alfred. Also scoring goals for the Lady Saxons were junior midfielders Jessica Giuricich (Blairstown, NJ/Blair Academy) and Rosemary O'Sullivan (Cold Spring Harbor, NY/Cold Spring) and sophomore defender Erika Richter (Floral Park, NY/Floral Park). Fisher (3-0, 1-0 Empire 8) was led by Haley Koperski with four goals and an assist and Laurie Quackenbush with three goals and three assists. Sophomore goalie Ashley Oliver (Bethel, ME/Gould Academy) made 13 saves for Alfred. Jacquie Gilmore and Michele Bonnevie each played a half in net for Fisher and combined to make four saves. Alfred plays next on Tuesday, March 29, at 4 p.m. at Fredonia.
