<u>Seiji Hinton</u> will coach defensive backs; <u>Dalton Maska</u> will coach offensive linemen; and Jonathan Ruffin will coach wide receivers. All three are Alfred University graduates and former standout players for the Saxons.

Hinton graduated from AU in 2015 with a bachelor's degree in athletic training. He was a four-year member of the Saxon football team, lettering two years as a defensive back.
