Do You Need a Tdap Booster?

Get your vaccination over winter break. Tdap is the Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis vaccine that

protects adolescents and adults against whooping cough.

Pertussis, or whooping cough, is a highly contagious bacterial infection (sometimes fatal to infants) that causes uncontrollable, violent coughing, lasting several weeks to even months. Pertussis cases are on the rise in New York State and California has a statewide pertussis epidemic. Most adults have been vaccinated against pertussis, but resistance has been shown to wane over time. Therefore it is recommended that all adults aged 19 to 64 receive a Tdap booster.

Contact your Primary Health-Care Provider or County Health Department to find out where you can get your Tdap booster.
