

Installation artist to lecture, exhibit at Alfred University

Installation artist Monica Bock, an associate professor of sculpture at the University of Connecticut in Storrs, CT, will lecture on her work at noon Wednesday, Jan. 29, in room C, Binns Merrill Hall on the Alfred University campus. Her visit to Alfred is sponsored by the School of Art and Design at Alfred University. Bock will discuss her recent work, "which employs conceptually charged materials such as salt, soap and lead to negotiate the terms of motherhood as personal experience, social identity and cultural institutions." Her exhibition, "Repository (Dear As Salt)" will open with a reception at 5 p.m. Friday, Jan. 31, at artSite, 114 N. Main St., Wellsville. The exhibition will run through Feb. 13. Bock has exhibited her work nationally and internationally, including at the Chicago Cultural Center, Chicago's Museum of Contemporary Art, Mobius in Boston, Real Art Ways in Hartford, CT, and The Mattress Factory in Pittsburgh.
