You can prevent self-harm

Sept. 10 was World Suicide Prevention Day. It's easier than you think to help a student who may be considering self-harm. Asking about behavior and feelings, sharing your concern, and knowing a good referral, can be great first steps toward resolving problems.

It's a good idea to ask more about it when someone:

- * Talks or jokes about suicide
- * Drinks too much or uses other drugs
- * Gets unusually angry or violent
- * Takes dangerous risks or looks for hair-raising thrills
- * Stays away from friends and wants to be left alone
- * Loses interest in how he or she looks
- * Gives away belongings and favorite objects

People who are feeling depressed or have been through something extremely stressful may think about escaping their problems.
