Alfred University women soccer stuns Fredonia to avenge last year s 7-0 defeat 10/07/03

The Saxons' victory was in large part due to great goaltending by freshman Brianna Paquette (West Burke, VT/St. Johnsbury Academy) and two impressive goals by junior Ellen Brandfonbrener (Franklin, MA/Medway). Alfred (3-6-1, 0-2-1) got things started when Brandfonbrener scored by booting the ball towards Fredonia's net from thirty yards away. The Saxon scored again with 8:53 remaining in the second half, when Brandfonbrener was taken down in the Fredonia box and awarded a penalty kick. Her kick was denied, but she put in her own rebound for the goal. Paquette went the distance in goal for the Lady Saxons, making seven saves for the shutout.
