Foster Lake Safety

Notice to All Foster Lake Access Pass Holders and Visitors:

Please be reminded that all pets MUST be on a leash and under the control of the owner at all times. If your pet is found to be unleashed, you and the pet will be asked to leave the premises immediately. Should injury or harm be threatened due to an uncontrolled animal, all Access Pass privileges of the threatening pet's owner may be revoked immediately for the remainder of the year.

Leashing your pet is a courtesy and respect to others. Your pet must be under your control and in your sight at all times.

Keep in mind, all County and State regulations still apply and, therefore, your pet needs to be registered, licensed, and vaccinated.

Foster Lake is a lovely place to bring your family and pets to play, and safety is our primary concern. To that end, please remember to completely extinguish all fires and never leave them smoldering. The fires should be cool to the touch and monitored for at least 30 minutes after having been extinguished. All fires should be contained to the grill stations and no fires should be lit on the ground.
