

AU ski teams compete at Cornell Invitational

ITHACA, NY The Alfred University Alpine ski teams competed at the Cornell Invitational over the weekend, where the men finished fifth of 12 teams competing and the women were seventh of 11 teams competing. Leading the men's team was senior Matt Seavey (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) who took first place in the giant slalom and 23rd in the slalom. Junior Jared Mostue (Hopkinton, NH/Proctor Academy) also had a strong weekend, finishing seventh in the giant slalom and third in the slalom. Leading the women's team was junior Anna Rung (Colden/Springville) with a 20th place finish in the giant slalom and a 13th in slalom. Senior Kelly Farrell (Meriden, NH/Kimball Union Academy) did not finish the giant slalom on Saturday after she injured her left hand but came back and skied the slalom on Sunday and recorded a 17th place finish.
