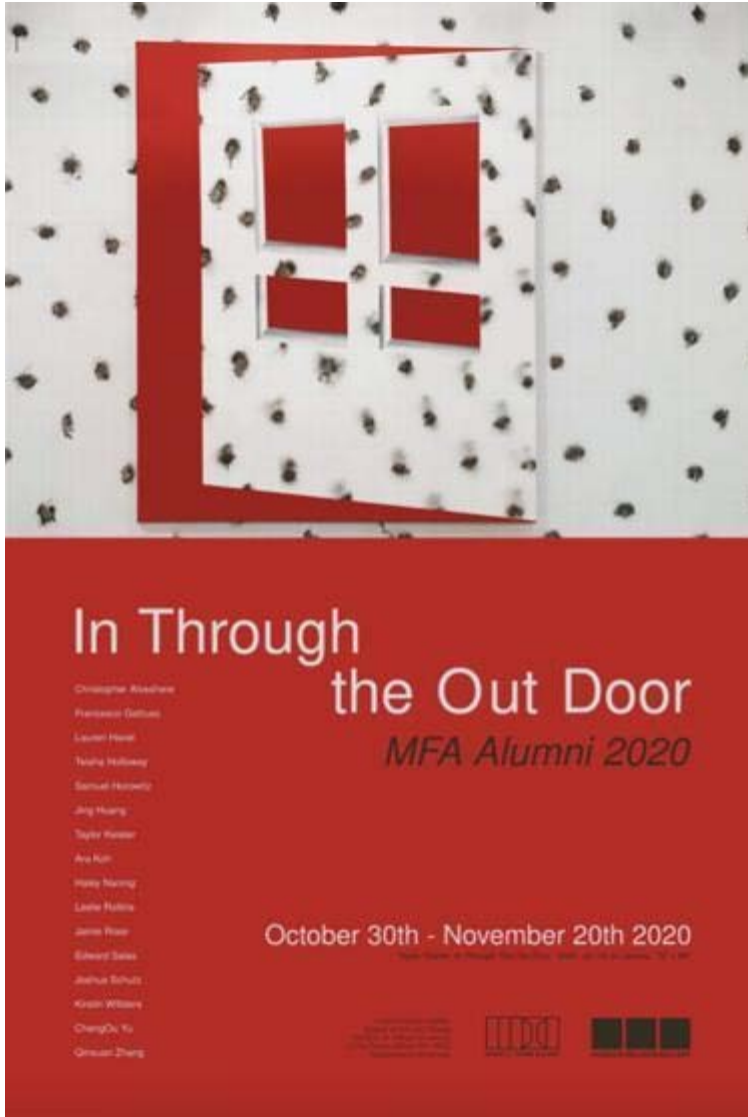


'In through the Out Door' opens today in Harder Hall galleries

An art exhibit curated entirely by Alfred University students opens today, Friday, Oct. 30, in the Fosdick-Nelson and Robert C. Turner galleries, both in Harder Hall.

In through the Out Door: MFA Alumni 2020 features Artwork by 2020 graduates from the Master of Fine Arts program at Alfred University's School of Art and Design. It was curated by student interns overseeing the Turner Gallery and student interns under the direction of Sharon McConnell, director of the Fosdick-Nelson Gallery

The event gives the public a chance to see in person artwork from last spring's MFA Thesis Exhibition. Due to COVID-19, the popular MFA thesis shows were moved to a virtual, online format.
