Sophomore designated hitter Jen Close (Lodi, NY/South Seneca) had two hits and an RBI, while senior centerfielder Courtney Briganti (Canisteo, NY/Canisteo) went 2-2. Curran got the complete-game victory for AU in the second contest, scattering four hits over seven innings while striking out six and walking none. Sophomore catcher Gretchen Weidner (Eden, NY/Eden) had a hit and drove in two runs for the Saxons. Junior first baseman Emilie Vicchio (Shaker Heights, OH/Shaker Heights) and Curran each went 2-3, while Mastin went 1-3 with a double. Vicchio and senior second baseman Andrea Crandall (Alfred, NY/Alfred-Almond) each scored runs for AU.Alfred (16-14, 4-8 Empire 8) wraps up its 2005 season Monday, May 2, at 6 p.m. with a doubleheader against Pitt-Bradford at Quackenbush Field in Wellsville.
