

Visiting speaker to discuss the 'geology of slag'

Alfred University's Geology Speaker Series continues on Friday, March 30, at 12:20 p.m. in Room 228 of the Science Center with a discussion on the geology of slag. The public is invited free of charge; refreshments will be served. The 50-minute program will feature Dr. Dori Farthing, assistant professor of geology at the State University of New York (SUNY) at Geneseo, who will discuss "The geology of slag - a mineralogical, geochemical, and environmental investigation." Farthing earned her B.A. degree in geology from the College of Wooster, and M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in geology from the Johns Hopkins University. After serving as a visiting professor at the University of Dayton for three years, she joined the faculty at SUNY Geneseo in 2004. Farthing's research interests are in all aspects of earth materials.
