Other top performers for AU were freshman Page Beecher (Scarborough, ME/Scarborough) second in the 1000 freestyle and the 200 individual medley and third in the 200 backstroke, junior Alex Crowell (Wayland, MA/Wayland) second in the 50 freestyle and the 100 freestyle, freshman Jon Wordingham (Prattsburgh/Naples) second in the 200 backstroke, Jewell second in the 500 freestyle, sophomore Lawrence Toebbe III (Merrimack, NH/Trinity) second in the 200 breaststroke, freshman Denis Eagan (Maplewood, NJ/St. Peters) third in the 1000 freestyle, Striker third in the 200 freestyle, senior Bill Brown (Chaffee/Pioneer) third in the 50 freestyle and junior Jay Ferrio (Allentown, PA/Emmaus) third in the 500 freestyle. The AU team of Striker, Brown, Crowell and Martin won the 400 freestyle relay, while Wordingham, Gotham, Brown and sophomore Trevor Covey (Alburg, VT/Burlington) finished first in the 400 medley relay. The Alfred University women's team (2-1, 1-1 Empire 8) got wins from freshman Danielle Sandy (Saratoga Springs/Saratoga) in the 1000 freestyle, the 200 butterfly, and the 500 freestyle, senior Lauren McCormack (Norwich/Norwich) in the 50 freestyle, junior Rachel Saroka (Groton/Groton) in the 100 freestyle, senior Lacy Clifford (Oil City, PA/Oil City) in the 200 backstroke and freshman Bethany Ackley (Horseheads/Horseheads) in 1-meter diving.
