ALFRED Two members of the Alfred University men's lacrosse team were given honorable mention by the Empire Eight conference, which announced its 2001 all-star teams this week. Freshman attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) and senior attack R.J. Dawson (Northampton, MA/Northampton) were both named to the honorable mention squad. Vail, despite missing three games due to illness, led the team in scoring with 40 points on 19 goals and a team-high 21 assists. He finished the year with 31 ground balls, tops on the team among attackmen. Dawson was second on the team in scoring with 29 points, including a team-high 20 goals to go with nine assists.
