

## AU men's lacrosse team cruises to victory

ALFRED The Alfred University men's lacrosse team easily defeated SUNY Brockport 20-4, on Saturday afternoon at Merrill Field. Alfred (2-1, 0-0 Empire 8) unleashed their offense minutes after the game began, scoring seven unanswered goals in the first quarter and four in the second while only allowing one from Brockport. After intermission, AU continued to control the field netting a total of nine goals safely securing the Saxons victory. Senior midfielder Steve Douglas (Horseheads/Horseheads) led AU's offensive frenzy with four goals and two assists. Junior attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) added three goals and three assists while junior attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) had three goals and two assists. The midfield pair of junior Anthony Fiorelli (Endicott/Union Endicott) and freshman Carlo DiRisio (Prattsburgh/Penn Yan) accounted for four goals and two assists, with each player posting two goals and one assist. Sophomore Nicholas Hohman (Gibsonia, PA/Pine Richland) and senior Matt Jones (Waterloo/Waterloo) split time in goal for AU. Hohman maintained the nets for 52 minutes making 16 saves, while Jones collected three saves during the last eight minutes of action. Brockport (2-1, 0-0 SUNYAC) was led by sophomore Steve Reynolds and a trio of freshmen, Mike Beach, Trevor Lemner, and John Tanner who all added one goal apiece for the Golden Eagles. Goaltender John Contratto played 30 minutes in goal for Brockport and collected eight saves, while reserve Jim Amell played 27 minutes and made 14 saves. Logan Gaffney also saw three minutes of action and recorded one save. The Saxons will next host SUNY Potsdam on Sunday, March 23 at 1 p.m. on Merrill Field.
