

RIT defeats AU men's lacrosse team

ALFRED The Alfred University men's lacrosse team lost at home to RIT 13-6 Saturday afternoon at Merrill Field. The visiting Tigers (5-2, 2-0 Empire 8) led 4-1 after one period and increased the advantage to 6-1 midway through the second frame. Alfred (3-4, 1-2 Empire 8) trailed 8-4 at the half before RIT opened the second half with two goals for a 10-4 advantage. AU scored a pair of goals in the third but was shut out in the fourth as RIT pulled away. Junior attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) paced Alfred with two goals and an assist. Junior attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) scored a pair of goals, while senior midfielder Greg Gascon (Buffalo/Bishop Timon) and junior midfielder Anthony Fiorelli (Endicott/Union-Endicott) each found the net once. Junior attack Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) had an assist. Sophomore Nicholas Hohman (Gibsonia, PA/Pine-Richland) made 11 saves in goal for Alfred. RIT was led by freshman attack David Thering (Fairport/Fairport) with four goals and three assists. Junior attack Chris Copeland (Webster/Webster) scored three goals while midfielder Ryan Neward (Williamsville/Williamsville East) and senior attack Andrew Pratt (Rochester/Irondequoit) each added two goals and an assist. Junior Jon Sinclair (Herndon, VA/Herndon) made 15 saves in goals for RIT. Alfred's next game is Wednesday, April 9, at 4 p.m. at Genesee.
