

Saxons defeat St. John Fisher College

ALFRED The Alfred University men's lacrosse team continued its Empire 8 conference schedule with a decisive 24-1 victory over St. John Fisher College Wednesday evening on a snow-covered Merrill Field. After giving up the opening goal to the Cardinals, the Saxons (5-2, 1-1 Empire 8) took charge of the game. The squad struck quickly and often to build a 15-1 halftime advantage. Leading Alfred was sophomore attack Dylan Macro (Camillus/West Genesee) with six goals and three assists. Sophomore attack David Vail (Mt. Lakes, NJ/Mt. Lakes) chipped in with three goals and five assists, while sophomore midfielder Trevor Archer (Penn Yan/Penn Yan) added three goals and two assists. Senior midfielder Gregory Gascon (Buffalo/Bishop Timon) contributed three goals to the winning cause. In goal for the Saxons, senior Kevin Kazmierczak (West Seneca/Orchard Park) played the first half and collected four saves. Freshman Nicholas Hohman (Gibsonia, PA/Pine Richland) faced light action in the second half and had one save. For the Cardinals, junior Matthew St. Croix had the lone goal. Freshmen Joe Alonge and Matt Nirelli split the game in the nets; Alonge had nine first-half saves and Nirelli had five in the second half. The next game for the Saxons is Saturday, April 6 when they travel to the Rochester Institute of Technology for a 1 p.m. contest.
