All employee and student activities involving the use of respiratory protection equipment, as defined in Alfred University's written program, shall be conducted in compliance with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA's) standard for respiratory protection 29 CFR 1910.134.

Alfred University will provide training to ensure (1) the correct type of equipment is chosen; (2) it is clean and in good working order; (3) a good fit is obtained; and (4) the user is adequately trained in the use, care and limitations of the protective device.

Miller Lecture on Ethical Issues in Medicine

Blending Modern Medicine with Ancient Tribal Customs: Lori Arviso Alvord, the first Navajo woman surgeon, (associate dean, Student & Multicultural Affairs, & assistant professor of surgery, Dartmouth Medical School) will relate her attempt to bring state-of-the-art skills to a culture in which the removal of organs was strongly resisted. Integrating a Navajo approach to healing -- "Walking in Beauty" -- enabled her to establish trusting relationships with patients as well as harmony in the operating room, which she found to be as necessary to healing as the correct surgical procedure. Her autobiography, the "Scalpel and the Silver Bear" will be available for purchase at the bookstore the day and evening of the lecture.
