## Alice Zhang is the Grand Prize Winner of 2017 "Young Pianist Competition" a

Fifteen year old Alice Zhang from Vernon Hills, Illinois, is the 2017 "Young Pianist Competition" Grand Prize Winner announced at the MostArts Festival Gala Concert, Saturday night. Alice Zhang will receive a \$10,000 cash prize, an invitation to become a Young Steinway Artist, and will return to Alfred University for the opening Gala Concert at the 2018 MostArts Festival next July.

Fifteen year old Raymond Feng from Pittsford, New York took the \$5000 second prize.

Seventeen year old Scarlett Zheng of Cranford, New Jersey was awarded 3rd prize and \$1500, as well as the Audience Favorite Award for her moving performance of the Mozart Piano Concerto No. 20.

The festival's youngest competitor, thirteen year old Aliya Alsafa of Chicago, Illinois, also won Friday evening's Audience Favorite award for her beautiful performance of the Mozart Piano Concerto No. 15.

In addition to these prizes, the Judges Discretionary Award of \$1,000 went to two sixteen year olds Siyu Yang of Syosset, New York and William Yang of Lexington, Massachusettes, for their brilliant solo recital performances. Other Merit Certificates were award to seventeen year old David Godar of Cincinnati, Ohio and Christian Chiu from Pittsburg, Pennsylvania.

The International jurors for the "Young Pianist Competition" included Angelin Chang, Steinway artist and German born pianist, Andreas Klein and American pianist, Anthony Pattin.

Closing remarks were offered by the President of Alfred University, Mark Zupan, who presented the University's Fiat Lux Award to Lisa Lantz

# "Circle and Square" at the Cohen Gallery through August 4

Circle and Square, a survey of William Underhill's cast bronze, iron, and aluminum sculptures, features pieces dating from 1960 through his current work.

Underhill's work formally explores the vessel and architectural form. Circle and Square highlights sculpture that demonstrates a sophisticated use of geometry. William Underhill is an emeritus faculty member who taught at NYSCC, School of Art and Design at Alfred University, from 1969 to 1997. During this time he taught sculpture and established the first bronze foundry. Underhill's contributions helped to significantly expand the Division of Sculpture/ Dimensional Studies.

### NaturalizeNY: Lottery will provide vouchers for free citizenship

Governor Cuomo's Office for New Americans has launched its second round of NaturalizeNY assisting New Yorkers with the path to citizenship. As a result, New York State will lottery off 1,500 vouchers that cover the cost of applying for U.S. citizenship (worth \$725) as well as all associated legal services. The initiative is called NaturalizeNY < http://www.NaturalizeNY.o...> < http://www.NaturalizeNY.o...>.

The lottery is free to enter and open to all citizenship-eligible legal permanent residents (green card holders) residing in New York State who meet certain income requirements. This means that you do not have to be a SUNY affiliate to apply for the lottery. Anyone who meets the eligibility requirements can also register and win.
