AU Business Administration Senior Gets National Scholarship Award 9/14/99

Alfred, NY -- After a national competition to judge the academic excellence of business students nationwide, Michael Pellicciotti, a senior at Alfred University, has been named a 1999 Delta Mu Delta Scholar. The award includes a \$750 scholarship, to be used toward Pellicciotti's studies during his senior year. He was one of only 39 business students nationally to receive scholarships. The 39 scholarships totaled \$27,500 for 1999. A graduate of Munster High School in Munster, IN, Pellicciotti is the son of Joseph and Beth Pellicciotti of Munster. Delta Mu Delta is the national honor society in business administration. Its purposes are to "promote higher scholarship in training for business, and to recognize and reward scholastic attainment in business subjects." The competition was judged on scholastic achievement, leadership, need, character, motivation, and potential. To be eligible for a Delta Mu Delta scholarship, students must be enrolled in a business program at a school where Delta Mu Delta has a chapter. The competition is open to juniors, seniors, and master's degree candidates in business.
