Alfred (5-5-3, 2-2-0 Empire 8) got on board just before the break when senior Adam Morgan (Byron, NY/Byron-Bergen) found the back of the net to give the Saxons a 1-0 advantage at the half. Morrisville knotted the game eight minutes in to the second period on an unassisted strike from freshman Segun Ajiboye. Alfred answered back with five goals in the last 30 minutes of the game. Junior Adam Long (Bath, NY/Haverling) and senior David Suddaby (Baldwinsville, NY/C.W. Baker) both added goals for the Saxons, while senior Bobby Linaberry (Manlius, NY/Fayetteville-Manlius) had two scores which broke Alfred's all time career points and goals mark.
