Testing Emergency Alert System

On Tuesday, campus community members will receive an e-mail, text message, fax, or automated phone call from the NY-Alert system. The text of the campus message will contain the phrase "Alfred University TEST of emergency notification system."

Your campus affiliation and the contact information you provided when you signed up for NY-Alert will determine the method(s) of communication (i.e. e-mail, fax, text message). When you receive a message on Tuesday, please note the time. We will be administering a survey after the test to assess the effectiveness of the communication.
