

Saxon men take third at Harvest Relays

ROCHESTER The Alfred University men's swimming team took third place out of eight teams at the Harvest Relays hosted by the University of Rochester Saturday afternoon. The Saxons finished with 145 point while Carnegie Mellon won the meet with 194 points. RIT placed second with 157 points. In the 3 x 100 backstroke relay, senior Todd Striker (Caledonia/York), junior Pat Kerwin (Canandaigua/Canandaigua) and freshman Mike Dube (Williamsburg, VA/Lafayette) placed second with a time of 2:43.93. The 200 freestyle relay team of Kerwin, sophomore Carl Schwarting (Weedsport/Weedsport), freshman Matt McNamara (Livonia/Livonia) and Striker placed second with a time of 1:28.80. The 400 freestyle relay team of Striker, Schwarting, Kerwin and senior Ben Meissner (Churchville/Byron-Bergen) placed second with the time of 3:22.22. The Saxons will have their next meet on Saturday, November 18, at 1 p.m. when they host Geneseo.
