Dr. Woolhandler practices primary care internal medicine at The Cambridge Hospital and teaches at Harvard where she is an Associate Professor of Medicine and co-Director of the General Internal Medicine Fellowship Program. In 1986, she co-founded Physicians for a National Health Program, which advocates a single-payer system of national health insurance for the U.S. She has authored more than 50 research articles on health care access and financing.
