

AU equestrian team competes at St. Lawrence

CANTON, NY The Alfred University equestrian team competed at St. Lawrence Saturday, placing ninth of 14 teams. Freshman Caitlin Hartman (Henrietta, NY/Rush-Henrietta) placed first in advanced walk-trot-canter. In three shows this season, Hartman has taken home the first-place blue ribbon each time. Freshman Katherine Kennedy (Horseheads, NY/Horseheads) earned her first blue ribbon of the season, taking first in intermediate equitation on the flat. Kennedy also picked up a third place in intermediate equitation over fences. Other top riders for AU were senior Bethany Cohen (Saratoga Springs, NY/Saratoga), second in walk-trot; freshman Shaina Muir (Columbus, OH/Dublin-Sciota), third in intermediate equitation over fences; and freshman Danielle Weimer (Lima, NY/Honeoye Falls-Lima), third in advanced walk-trot-canter. Also picking up points for Alfred were freshman Stacy Eaker (Addison, NY/Addison), fourth in walk-trot; sophomore Lisa Landis (New City, NY/Clarkstown North), fourth in intermediate equitation on the flat; freshmen Maria Koronkiewicz (Bellport, NY/Bellport) and freshman Theresa Wills (Ransomville, NY/Lewiston-Porter), each fourth in open equitation over fences, with Koronkiewicz and Wills also taking fifth and sixth, respectively, in open equitation on the flat; freshman Corey Urtel (Lockport, NY/Wilson), fifth in advanced walk-trot-canter; freshman Noelle Orłowski (Wilson, NY/Mt. St. Mary Academy), sixth in novice equitation on the flat; and freshman Katie Mix (Warsaw, NY/Warsaw) and sophomore Holly White (Wayland, NY/Wayland-Cohocton), each sixth in novice equitation over fences.
